Beach Rules and Information

LAKE FACILITIES ARE FOR PARK DISTRICT RESIDENTS (AND THEIR GUESTS) ONLY

PARK DISTRICT WRISTBANDS ARE REQUIRED TO USE THE BEACHES

Residents are required to have Beach Identification Wristbands to use the beaches and present to the lifeguard or designated park district official upon request. At least one family representative or person in charge of children or a group is required to wear a wristband.

BEACH RULES

- No swimming unless lifeguard is on duty
- Children under 12 MUST be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older)
- All guests must be accompanied by a Park District resident
- Lifeguards are to be obeyed at all times
- Keep clear of lifeguard chair, boat and rescue equipment

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT PERMITTED:

- Swimming under the raft/docks
- Swimming beyond the ropes, docks unless permitted by Lifeguard
- Hanging on ropes, buoy, ladders or lifeguard equipment
- Glass or sharp objects
- Large rafts/floats in the shallow area
- Rafts/floats beyond the end of dock unless permitted by Lifeguard
- Masks/snorkels at the discretion of the lifeguard
- Use of “swimmies”, rings, floats, noodles, life jackets past the shallow line unless permitted by Lifeguard
- Use of threatening, obscene or abusive language or behavior
- Alcoholic beverages
- Pets
- Smoking
- Throwing of rocks or sand
- Fishing in the beach area
